Autoantibodies to myeloperoxidase (MPO) are commonly associated with the following small-vessel vasculitides: microscopic polyangiitis, polyarteritis nodosa, Churg-Strauss syndrome, necrotizing and crescentic glomerulonephritis and occasionally Wegeners granulomatosis. The perinuclear IFA pattern, (p-ANCA) is based largely on autoantibody to myeloperoxidase which serves as the primary antigen.

These autoantibodies are present in active disease state.
