< or = 0.90	Negative - No VZV IgG Antibody detected			
0.91 - 1.09	Equivocal			
> or = 1.10	Positive - VZV IgG Antibody detected			
<p>A positive result indicates that the patient has antibody to VZV but does not differentiate between infection (active or past) and vaccination. The clinical diagnosis must be interpreted in conjunction with the clinical signs and symptoms of the patient. This assay reliably measures immunity due to previous infection but may not always be sensitive enough to detect antibodies induced by vaccination. Thus, a negative result in a vaccinated individual does not necessarily indicate susceptibility to VZV infection.</p>
